### WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The recent World Championships could be viewed on satellite TV—Eurosports as well as the Internet. I for one whenever possible took the opportunity to watch some matches on the ITTF TV site.

The Chinese domination was not a surprise though the winner of the Men's Singles was somewhat unexpected. They won all the events!!!!

English players did reasonably well, Kelly Sibley & Joanna Parker came through their qualification groups in the Women's Singles, Sibley losing in straight sets to Ma Eum Song and Parker was very unlucky to lose her 7 sets encounter against Yuka

Ishigaki 13-15 in the decider.

In the Men's Singles Paul Drinkall had as his opponent in the first round proper the seasoned and highly ranked Vladimir Samsanov who won in straight sets. Liam Pitchford lost his match against Koki Niwa of Japan 2-4 in an entertaining match. Carlos Machado of Spain beat Andrew Baggaley 4-1 also in the 1st round.

None of our Men's doubles partnerships made it through to the main rounds. Kelly Sibley & Joanna Parker did qualify in the women's doubles, losing their first round to Ai Fukuhara and Kaumi Ishikawa of Japan 0-4.

Parker won their 1st round encounter, just!!, 4-3, beating Chaisit Chaitat & Nanthana Komwong of Thailand and were then defeated in the next round by Yuk Cheung and Hua-jun Jiang of Hong Kong.

Well done!!

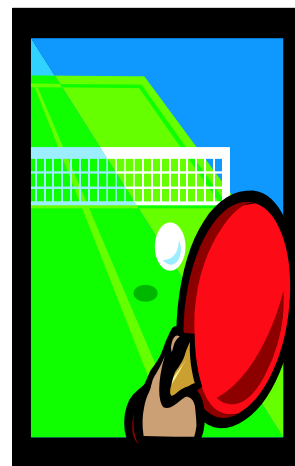
The County 1st team—finished runners-up to Berkshire 1 having won 5, drawn 1 and lost 1.

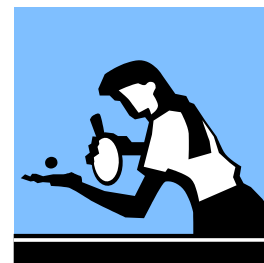
